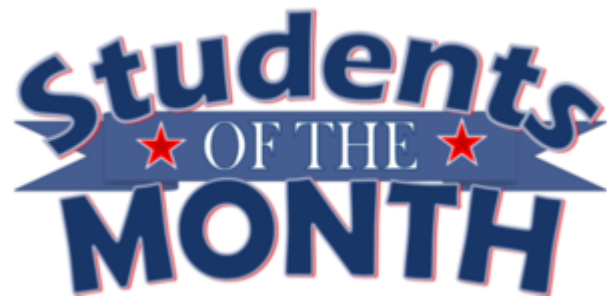


**Beal City Elementary Students of the Month

Students Learn the Effects of Vaping

Students from the Freshman Health class recently created models of lungs using paper bags and different size straws after learning how vaping affects the bronchii and aveoli. The smaller straws showed decreased oxygen intake from smoking or vaping. The larger straws showed unrestricted oxygen intake. We defined popcorn lung and how smoking and vaping affect circulation.
