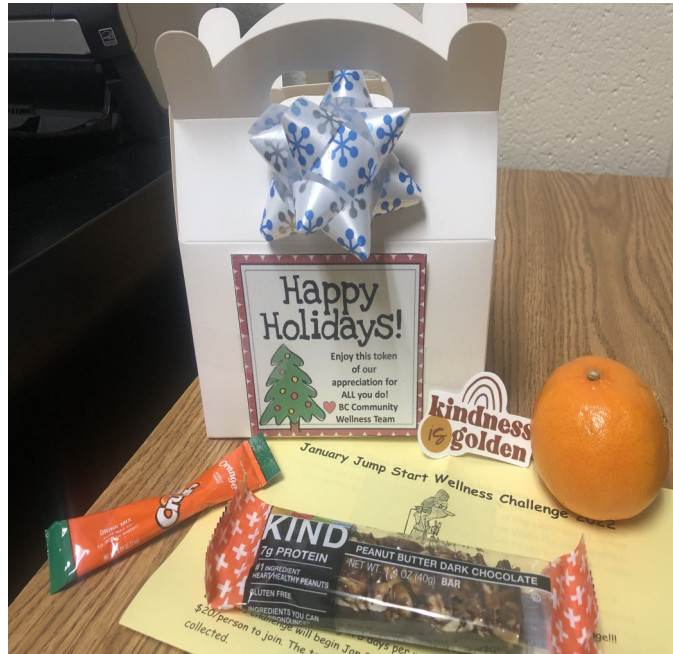

In November, students were provided with several volunteer opportunities such as assisting with the CCW Turkey Dinner, removing Veteran’s Day flags from the Beal City cemetery to be stored for next year, and writing personalized Christmas cards for use by the Foster Closet of Isabella County. In December, members made over 40 tie blankets with the Mt. Pleasant Kiwanis Club for Christmas Outreach. We also had several members volunteer at Beal City’s Hometown Christmas. In January, we will be partnering with the National Honor Society to offer three exam study sessions for students in grades 8-12.
