BEAL CITY PUBLIC SCHOOLS SELECTS JASON LUNDIN TO LEAD DISTRICT

Beal City Public Schools Board of Education has selected Jason Lundin as the district's next superintendent. "We look forward to the next chapter of Beal City Schools with Jason. He has a collaborative, supportive, and engaging leadership style. His diverse background will inject new ideas and opportunities for our students and staff." stated board president Denise McBride. Lundin brings 24 years of educational experience, including considerable administrative experience in principal and director roles. The current Director of Academics at Chippewa Hills School District, Lundin, directs and coordinates all district educational processes, including curriculum alignment, instruction, programming, and staffing. Before that, Lundin served as District Coordinator of MTSS, middle school principal, assistant athletic director, math teacher, grant coordinator, and coach.

Consistent with Beal City Public Schools values, the selection was supported by a transparent and inclusive process. Selection criteria were generated based on the input of numerous community members, parents, and staff via an online survey. Additionally, administrators, faculty, staff, and community members provided input during structured stakeholder conversations. Stakeholders in attendance provided immediate feedback to board members during preliminary and final face-to-face candidate interviews. The board of education appreciates the district's citizens and staff's support of the process.

Jason Lundin and the board of education are currently in contract negotiations, with the new superintendent expected to assume the position no later than July 1, 2024.
